Mature and complex with deep layered flavors of forest floor and leather giving way to mint, coffee and cocoa that wrap themselves around muscular black currant, fig and black berry. The texture and mouth feel is soft, but the fine grained tannins provide ample support. The finish is a marathon of dark fruit and tobacco and well integrated oak and tannin. The 2005 is definitely an elegant "grand vin."
